Skills Support for the Workforce

- Support to 2,500 employed individuals aged 16+ with 1,500 progressing onto an apprenticeship, higher accredited learning or within work

Skills Support for the Workforce Priority Sectors

- Delivery of training units at Level 3 or above in the following sectors; nuclear, advanced manufacturing, transport / logistics / visitor economy, land based / agri-services, construction, health and social care.

Apprenticeship Services

- Increase number of apprentices from 2015 by 20% (increase of 1,000 starts per year)

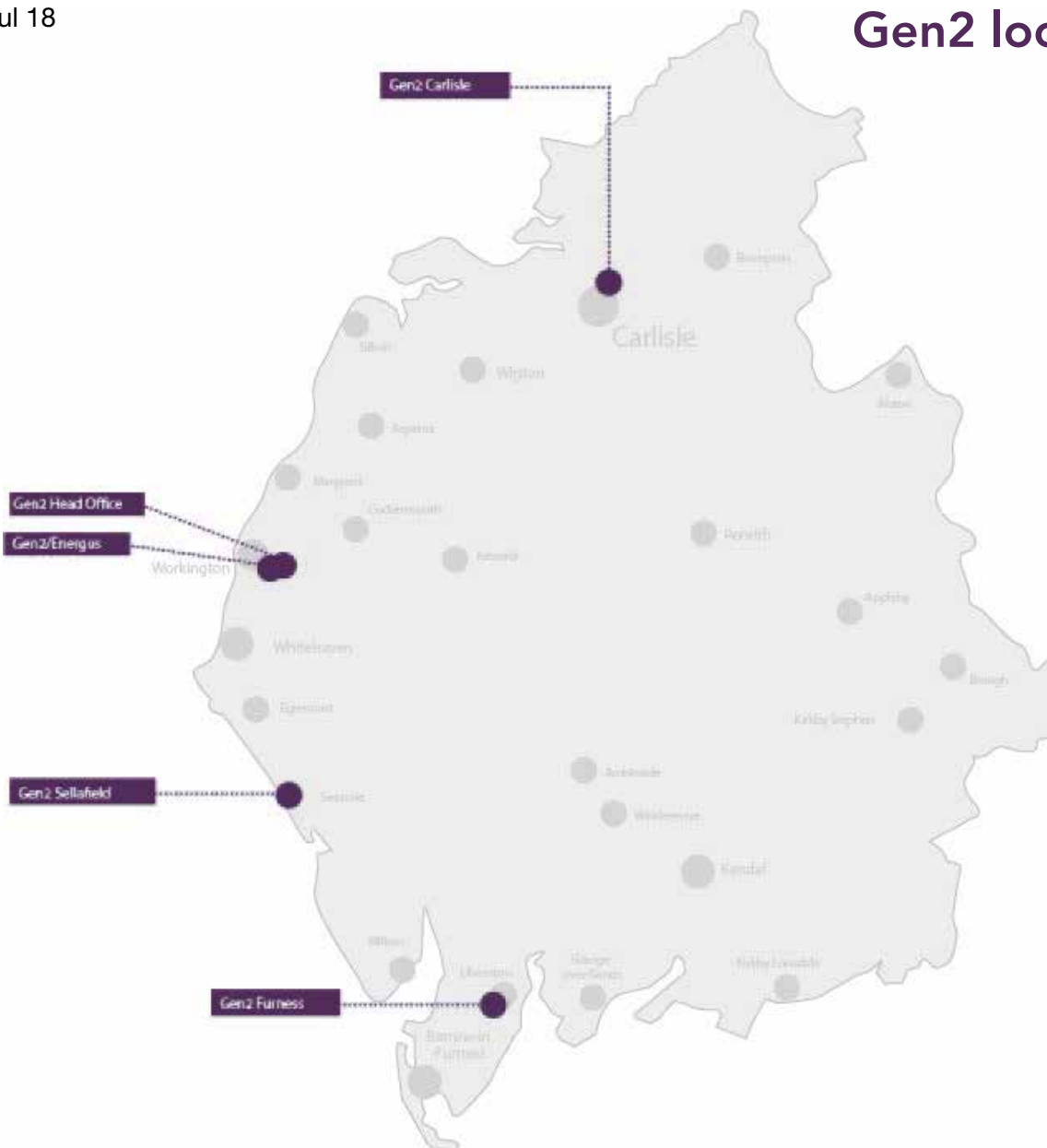
